

Medical Objects Picture Quiz

Object 1. Six rectangular objects. What are they? Who might use them?



Made from brass. Largest is approx. 1 inch wide.

Object 2. What is this? Who might have used it?



Curved, clear glass. Approx. 5 inches long

Object 3. What is this? Who might use it?



Wood and metal. Central metal rod rotates by means of handle. Frame approx. 9 inches wide (excluding handle).

Object 4. What are these? What might they have been used for?



Clear glass domes, largest approx. 2.5 inches tall.

Object 5. What are these? What might they have been used for?



Made from silver. Holes at either side of curved end. Smaller approx. 11 inches long. Longer approx. 13 inches long.

Object 6. What is this? What might it have been used for?



A rubber bulb, approx. 3 inches long, attached to rubber tubing into which a variety of different shaped nozzles or taps might be fitted.

Object 7. What is this? Who might have used it?



Large wooden tray with grooved brass section approx. 12 inches long with separate wood and brass flat rolling pin-shaped part.
